Harris Named Pitcher of Month

Joe Harris made some big appearances in July and was rewarded for his efforts. Harris was selected by the American Association as the Rawlings Pitcher of the Month for July. In July, Harris was a perfect 6-0 with a 1.69 ERA and three saves. He appeared in 14 of the RedHawks 27 games in the month. Harris pitched 21 1/3 innings and allowed five runs (four earned) on 16 hits. He struck out 19 batters and walked four.

### Jackson Homers His Way up The List

Nic Jackson is having another big year and its showing in the box scores and the club's all-time records list. With two home runs in the most recent homestand at Newman Outdoor Field, the Fargo-Moorhead outfielder sits at 59 home runs and is third in team history in the department. Jackson trails home-run leader Jesse Hoorelbeke who hit 65 during his time in Fargo-Moorhead, and Darryl Motley who hit 64 and is second on the all-time chart.

### Piepkorn Returns to RedHawks

A familiar name will be seen at Newman Outdoor Field for the first time at home this season. Jeremiah Piepkorn returned to the Fargo-Moorhead lineup during the three-game series at St. Paul, the first time since 2010. Piepkorn played parts of three seasons for the Red-Hawks from 2008-2010. His biggest year came during the championship season of 2009. That year, Piepkorn played in 92 games and batted .339 with 19 home runs and 73 RBIs.

### **Crushing Goldeyes Pitching**

The RedHawks' lineup has hit the Goldeyes' fifth-ranked pitching staff well in previous matchups. Ron Bourquin and C.J. Retherford both have over .400 batting averages against Winnipeg, while Zach Penprase, Todd Jennings and Keith Brachold are hitting over .300 in six games.

SOULEFUL WIN FOR SAINT'S AS THEY BEAT REDHAWKS 3-2 Courtesy: St. Paul Saints

ST. PAUL, MN (August 1, 2013) – As the calendar turns to the final month of the season the St. Paul Saints realize every game is important in their quest to reach the playoffs. Each player will need to step up in their own way and on Thursday night at Midway Stadium starting pitcher Billy Soule did just that as the Saints came from behind to defeat the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks 3-2 in front of 5,274.

Soule, who was a closer at the University of Minnesota during his four year career, has started his last three ballgames and been magnificent. He started off with a shaky first inning giving up a leadoff triple to Zach Penprase and then Ronnie Bourquin followed with an RBI single to give the RedHawks a 1-0 lead. Nic Jackson singled Bourquin to third and C.J. Retherford's RBI single made it 2-0. Soule failed to get an out after the first four hitters, but then he got into a groove. A double play ground out off the bat of Keith Brackhold and a fly out by Tim Alberts ended the inning. Soule gave up four hits in the first inning and allowed just three over the next six innings of work.

In innings two through seven Soule didn't allow a runner past first base and faced one over the minimum during those six innings. He went a career high 7.0 innings allowing two runs on seven hits while striking out three in picking up his second win of the season.

The Saints offense struck in the second inning when Brandon Tripp walked, moved to second on Ole Sheldon's single and scored on a single by Jose Hernandez to make it 2-1.

It stayed that way until the seventh when Trevor Hairgrove led off with a single to left. After Adam Frost walked, RedHawks starter Alex Caldera was relieved by the pitcher of the month in July, Joe Harris. Joey Becker reached on a fielder's choice with Frost being retired at second. Brad Boyer doubled down the third base line scoring Hairgrove to tie the game at two. After Willie Cabrera was intentionally walked to load the bases, Tripp's sacrifice fly gave the Saints a 3-2 lead.


That would be enough for the Saints bullpen as Bryan Henry pitched a perfect eighth inning and Matt Meyer closed out the game for his 14th save of the season.


