Win No. 1,000 in Sight

The RedHawks need two more wins to reach 1,000 in franchise history. The 'Hawks have six games to achieve the feat at home, with threegame series' against St. Paul and Sioux City. Overall, Fargo-Moorhead is 16-11 at home this season including its most recent home series being a three-game sweep of Sioux Falls from July 15-17.

Pitchers' Continued Success

With the second-best ERA as a team (3.35), the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks have been led by their pitching staff this season. Starting pitchers Taylor Stanton and Jake Laber rank in the league's Top 10 in ERA, while Alex Caldera and reliever Joe Harris are tied for the league lead in wins with eight. Five pitchers have under-3.00 ERA's, while only three in the rotation have ERA's over 4.00.

Bourguin Takes On Former Team

Ron Bourguin will take on his former team -- the St. Paul Saints -- for the second time this season and the first at Newman Outdoor Field. Bourguin played two seasons for the Saints, hitting a combined .291 with 23 home runs and 104 RBIs. Bourquin had a tough-go in the prior three games against St. Paul at Midway Stadium in June, going 1-for-12 with six strikeouts. Bourguin is second on the 'Hawks hitting .293.

Jackson Shines Despite Streak Ending

Although Nic Jackson's consecutive game-on base streak ended at 36 in a July 18 game at Sioux City, Jackson continues to be the 'Hawks' best hitter this month. In 19 July games, he has went 15-for-26 (.382) with four doubles and 18 RBIs. Jackson also became the club's all-time RBIs leader -- now with 370 total -- with 2 RBIs in the July 21 game in Sioux City. He passed Ruben Salazar, who had 369 and played from 2003-2009.

SIOUX CITY, Iowa - Fargo-Moorhead jumped out to a 7-0 lead in the third inning, but the Explorers came back with five runs in the bottom of the third, but eventually lost to the Red Hawks 13-10 in a wild Sunday night game at Lewis and Clark Park. The victory gave Fargo-Moorhead the series as they won three of the four games.

Between both teams there was a total of 33 hits in the game with Fargo-Moorhead getting 19 hits, the most the Explorers had given up this season. Zach Penprase, Nic Jackson, C.J. Retheford, Keith Brachold, Tim Alberts, and Mitch Einertson all had multi-hit games for the Red-Hawks; with Albers having a four hit night. Brachold's two run home run in the seventh ended up providing the game winning RBI.

The Explorers had 14 hits with five of those hits coming off the bat of Austin Gallagher. He became the first player this year with five hits for the Explorers.

Sioux City starter Andy Noga was chased after three innings where he gave up seven earned runs and took the loss for the Explorers. Fargo-Moorhead relief pitcher Nathan Kilcrease was the winner for the RedHawks. RedHawks starter Jake Laber lasted only four innings, allowing seven runs, with only three of them earned. Chase Johnson pitched the ninth to record the save.


