The Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks will continue their playoff push today and continue their series against the Kansas City Monarchs tonight at 7:02 p.m. at Newman Outdoor Field. The RedHawks have capitalized on Chicago's four-game losing streak and have stormed into second place in the North Division with three wins in their last four games. Jordan George led the way for Fargo-Moorhead in Monday night's 9-6 win with three RBIs and extended his on-base streak to 50 games, breaking the RedHawks' all-time record. RHP Andrew Tri (0-0, 9.00 ERA) will make his third start of the season for the RedHawks while Kansas City will start RHP Ryan Newell (1-0, 4.32 ERA).

REDHAWKS BANKING ON LEAGUE-BEST OFFENSE

With the American Association's best offense it would only make sense that the RedHawks are consistently winning games with their bats. So far this season Fargo-Moorhead has scored six or more runs in 36 of their 70 games this season and are 29-7 in such games. The RedHawks lead the AA in runs (454), hits (757), doubles (144), and total bases (1,175) this season. On the other hand, when Fargo-Moorhead doesn't score runs they struggle, as they only have two wins the entire season when they score three or less run. The last time the RedHawks scored that few runs and won the game was on June 12 when they beat Cleburne 2-1.

Andrew Tri joins the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks for his first season of professional baseball after three seasons of collegiate baseball at the University of St. Thomas (St. Paul, Minn.). Tri also previously played in the Prospect League for the West Virginia Miners in 2017 and in the Northwoods League for the Eau Claire Express in 2019.

In his three seasons at St. Thomas, Tri was 12-8 with a 3.30 ERA in 30 career collegiate games. He has 160 strikeouts compared to just 49 walks in 122.2 innings pitched in his career. This last season Tri made the all-region team, the Minnesota Intercollegiate Conference all-defensive team, and was selected to the all-conference first-team. Tri helped his team to an NCAA runner-up finish and was 1-1 in two College World Series starts.
