# TOMSHAW UNDEFEATED THROUGH FOUR STARTS

Since joining Fargo-Moorhead on August 11, 2021 left-handed starter Matt Tomshaw has been a key part of the RedHawks rotation, as he is 3-0 through his first four games with the team. Tomshaw has allowed only five runs through 20.1 innings pitched and has 20 strikeouts compared to only five walks so far this season. Tomshaw's 1.08 WHIP is the second best on the active roster (Luke Lind, .91 WHIP) and he leads all RedHawks pitchers this season with a strike percentage of 2.323%.

Matt Tomshaw returns to Newman Outdoor Field for his 11th season of professional baseball and second with Fargo-Moorhead after a standout 2020 season for the RedHawks. Tomshaw went 5-3 with a 2.69 ERA in 12 appearances (11 starts) and 80.1 innings pitched for Fargo-Moorhead in the COVID-shortened, 60-game 2020 season. Tomshaw limited opponents to a .230 average and only 1.046 walks and hits per inning pitched in 2020. He was named the American Association Pitcher of the Month for August and was twice named American Association Pitcher of the Week (August 2 & August 30), including a reunion with former Jack-sonville University teammate Adam Brett Walker II for the week ending August 30, when Tomshaw was named Pitcher of the Week and Walker was named Batter of the Week. Tomshaw ranked third in the American Association in ERA, fourth in wins, and second in innings pitched in 2020. He was the only AA pitcher with multiple complete games — he pitched three of them.

The Kingston, N.Y. native brings with him Triple-A experience, including stints with the Charlotte Knights (White Sox) and Rochester Red Wings (Nationals) in 2021. Tomshaw went 0-6 with a 7.86 ERA in 14 appearances (8 starts) split between the two Triple-A clubs to start 2021 before being released by the Nationals organization on August 6. He had previously made Triple-A appearances in 2015, 2018, and 2019. Tomshaw is 7-12 with a 6.78 ERA in 41 career games at the Triple-A level (21 starts).

A 42nd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 2011, Tomshaw played four seasons in the Twins organization — reaching Advanced-A ball three times — before being claimed off waivers by the Marlins system. He made an immediate step up in competition during the 2015 season, appearing in 31 games, including his first two Triple-A appearances with the New Orleans Zephyrs. Tomshaw pitched superbly in 2016, going 5-5 with a 3.23 ERA in 24 appearances (14 starts) split primarily between Double-A and Triple-A, with one game at Single-A. After a one-year absence, Tomshaw returned to Triple-A with Charlotte in 2018 and 2019 before being released by the White Sox organization on June 26, 2020 and signing with the RedHawks. Tomshaw was invited to participate in MLB Spring Training with the White Sox in 2020 and again in 2021 after his contract was transferred from Fargo-Moorhead to Chicago on January 18, 2021.

Tomshaw went 19-9 with a 4.61 ERA in 74 appearances (41 starts) over four seasons for the Jacksonville University Dolphins from 2009 to 2011. Tomshaw earned a spot on the Dean's List and was an Atlantic-Sun All-Academic Honors recipient at Jacksonville University — he majored in finance.

In his first varsity start for Kingston High School, Tomshaw no-hit Monroe-Woodbury. As a senior, Tomshaw was named player of the year and first team all-conference. As a junior, he allowed only 21 hits and struck out 71 batters in 47 innings pitched for the Tigers.
